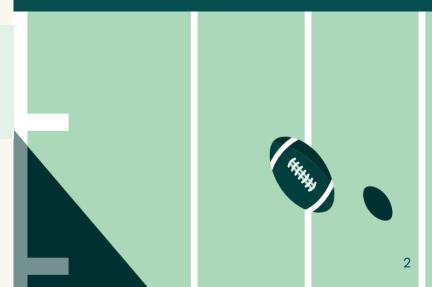

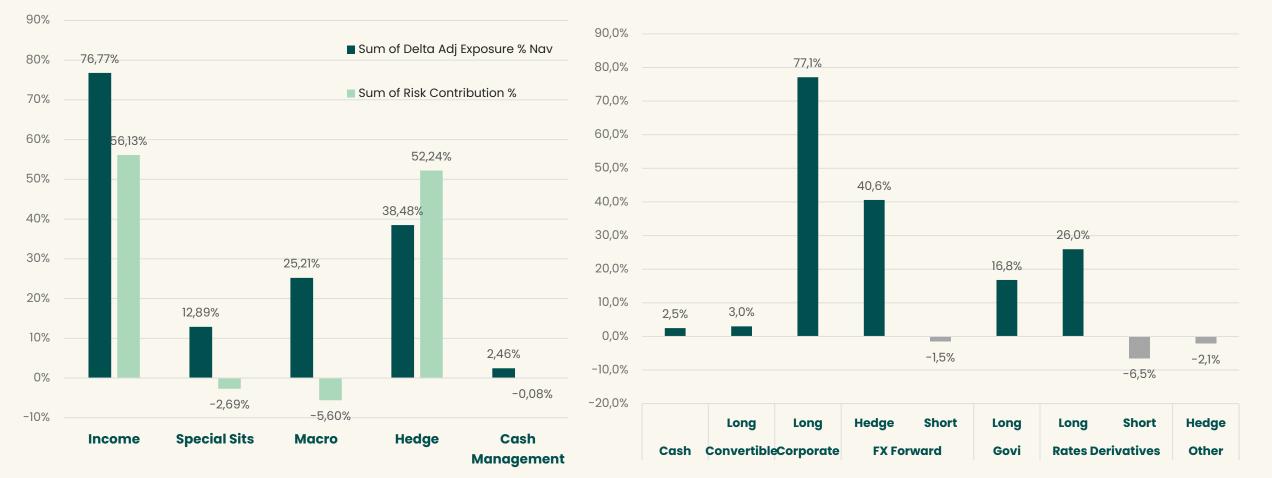
Current Portfolio Positioning

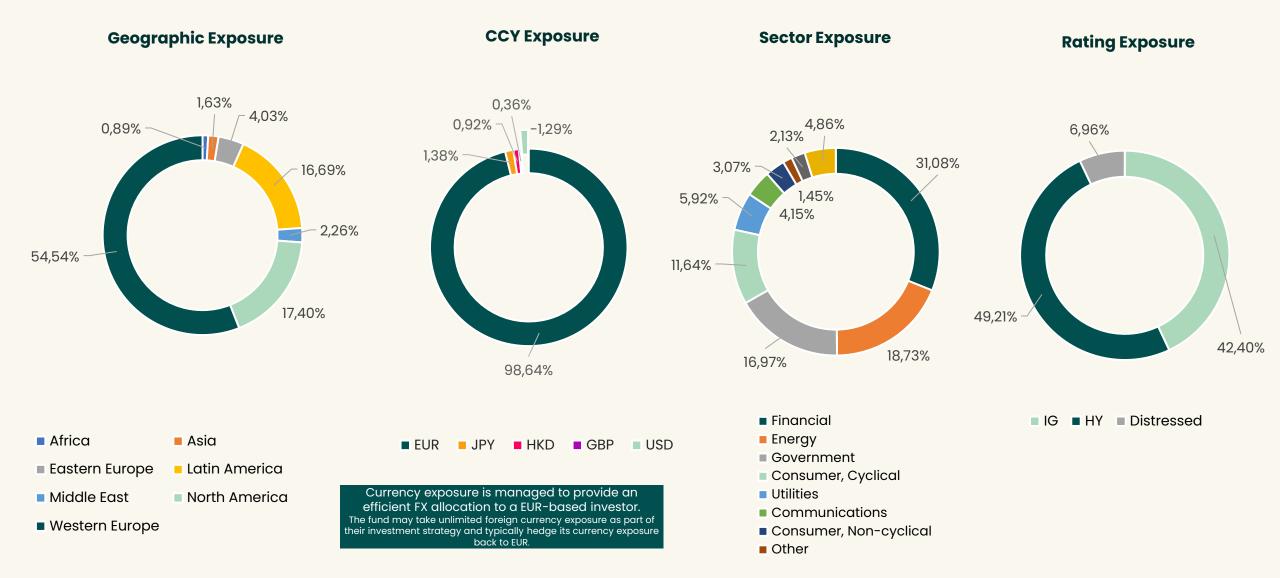

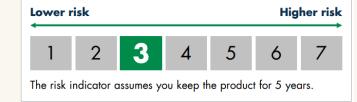
